## Overview of the event

Japan is one of the few countries in the world that has created new drugs, and while it possesses high potential for innovation, such as excellent basic research in academia and manufacturing technologies possessed by SMEs, it has been pointed out that it has not fully utilized its potential. In particular, ventures (medical ventures) that aim to commercialize pharmaceuticals, medical devices, regenerative medicine and other products are required to fully demonstrate their capabilities and to drive medical innovation in our country as in Europe and the United States.

In June of this year the Japanese government held the first public-private council meeting on improving drug discovery capabilities, where discussions were held on initiatives that contribute to the drug discovery ecosystem. Going forward, additional future discussions will be held concerning policies, challenges, and measures for improvement, to strengthen Japan's position in the realm of drug discovery.

In addition, the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare is working on adopting measures to create a virtuous cycle (ecosystem) for developing medical ventures, such as supporting practical applications of outstanding seeds.

To further accelerate this process, we will hold the Japan Healthcare Venture Summit 2025 in Pacifico Yokohama, following on from last year. At the Summit, medical ventures will have booths and presentations to provide opportunities for matching and networking with key people from major companies, financial institutions, research institutions, etc., and to create an environment in which stakeholders can deepen their understanding of the current state of regulatory and related systems and venture support initiatives.

We hope that medical ventures and academia, which have seeds that are expected to lead to innovative pharmaceuticals, medical devices, regenerative medicine and other products, will participate in this Summit and that it will serve as a place to step up toward practical application.
